

Information Sharing Entities

The Northern Territory Government agencies designated by the *Domestic and Family Violence Act 2007* as Information Sharing Entities (ISEs) are those responsible for child protection, adult correctional services, disability services, education, housing, public health, youth justice, police, courts and tribunals and any other government agency that provides a domestic violence related service.

Under this definition, the following government agencies are prescribed as ISEs:

- Department of Territory Families, Housing and Communities¹
- Department of Education
- Department of the Attorney-General and Justice (including NT Correctional Services)
- Department of Health
- Department of Local Government, Housing and Community Development
- NT Police
- Courts and tribunals²
- non-government schools.

In addition, the following non-government organisations that provide a domestic violence related service have applied to and been approved by the Minister for Prevention of Domestic Violence as ISEs under section 124DA(1) of the *Domestic and Family Violence Act 2007*, through amendments to the Domestic and Family Violence Regulations:
